Re: Remediation Services

RJW proposes to fullfill the following Scope of Work under NJ State contract including the following line items:

- 1. Excavate an area of approximately 14 ft. by 16 ft. by 13 ft. bgs and at the direction of Maser Consulting or until PID readings and field observation deem impacted soils have been removed. Place soil on 6 mil plastic.
- 2. Dispose of approximately 40 tons of impacted soil required to be remediated from 8 ft. to 13 ft. below surface grade within the excavation area (provide per ton cost). \$64.80/ton
- 3. Maser Consulting will collect post excavation soil samples following soil remediation.
- 4. Place and compact Dense Graded Aggregate (DGA) in 12-inch lifts fill to replace petroleum impacted soil. DGA material must be certificated clean fill and certification must be provided before material is placed on site. Place and compact excavated material from surface to eight (8) ft in 12 inch lifts to surface.
- 5. Remobilization to load soil into trucks for off site disposal
