**RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE SHARED SERVICE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE  
 BOROUGH OF RED BANK AND THE TOWNSHIP OF SHREWSBURY FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL  
 SERVICES**

**WHEREAS**, the Uniform Shares Services and Consolidation Act, N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 et seq. authorizes municipalities to contract with each other for shared services; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Red Bank has entered into a Professional Service Contract with the Community Health Group d/b/a JFK University Medical Center for emergency medical ambulance services within the Borough from January 1, 2023 to December 31, 2023;

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Red Bank and the Township of Shrewsbury wish to enter into a Shared Service Agreement for emergency medical services provided by the Borough of Red Bank through its contractor aforesaid to Shrewsbury Township as a Shared Service Agreement for CY2023 at an annual fee of \$8,000.00 per year and at a rate of \$666.67 per month, beginning January 1, 2023 and terminating December 31, 2023; and

**WHEREAS**, the Chief Financial Officer will place sufficient funds for this contract in the CY2023 municipal budget; and,

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Township Committee of the Township of Shrewsbury, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, that the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute a Shared service Agreement, prepared by the Township Attorney with the Borough of Red Bank for emergency medical services for the benefit of Shrewsbury Township commencing January 1, 2023 and terminating December 31, 2023 for an annual fee of \$8,000.00; and at a rate of \$666.67 per month, beginning January 1, 2023 and terminating December 31, 2023.
