Appointing Code Enforcement and Housing Officer

Whereas, there is a vacancy in the position of Code Enforcement and Housing Officer in the Township of Shrewsbury, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, and

Whereas, Thomas Welsh has served as Temporary Code and Housing Officer since January 24, 2017, and

Whereas, there is a need for an experienced Code Enforcement and Housing Officer to oversee those operations and issue Certificates of Occupancy in Shrewsbury Township, and

Whereas, Thomas Welsh, Shrewsbury Township Fire Marshall and Deputy OEM Coordinator, has experience in these areas and has fulfilled these responsibilities for other Monmouth County municipalities,

Now be it resolved, that Thomas Welsh be appointed Code Enforcement/Housing Officer commencing April 11, 2017 at a salary of \$3,000 per annum for code enforcement, and \$6,000 per annum for Housing Officer prorated, to be paid monthly.
