RESOLUTION 2017-6 Appointment of Township Bond Counsel

- 1. Meghan Clark of the firm of Gluck-Walrath is hereby designated as Township Bond Counsel for the Township of Shrewsbury beginning January l, 2017 and ending December 31, 2017
- 2. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute a contract according to law and in accordance with this resolution. A copy of said contract shall be filed with the Clerk of the Township and shall be available for public inspection.
- 3. That the Township shall fund said award through its 2017 budget, Legal O/E in the amount not to exceed \$5,000, and Capital ordinances as needed. No amount of any contract shall be chargeable until certification of available funds are made and upon receipt of a properly executed Purchase Order pursuant to the rules of the Local Finance Board of the State of New Jersey. Payments shall be made in accordance with the schedule affixed to the RFP for Bond Counsel Services.
- 4. This appointment is made in accordance with the Local Public Contracts Law, and the fair and open process as provided by NJSA 40A:11 et.seq.
- 5. A Notice of this appointment shall be advertised in an official newspaper of the Township of Shrewsbury as required by law.
- 6. That upon the adoption of the within resolution, the Clerk is authorized and directed to forward a certified copy of it to the Township CMFO.
